

USING THE STANLEY LANDFILL

Please consider storing any landfill materials at home whenever possible and limiting the number of trips made to the landfill to help us continue planking the curve. If you or anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-like symptoms, please do not use the landfill until you are symptom free. Wearing a mask is encouraged.

Following the recommendations provided by the Ontario Government and Public Health, the following operating procedure will be put in place at the Stanley Landfill beginning June 17, 2020 until further notice to protect the public and municipal staff.

1. Landfill users **MUST** present a valid Stanley Landfill Pass (blue card) to the landfill attendant. Visitors to the landfill who do not have a valid landfill pass will not be able to use the Stanley Landfill and will be asked to leave the landfill without unloading.
2. Landfill users are required to present their landfill pass to the landfill attendant by holding it up to their car window along with valid photo identification for the landfill attendant to see. Windows are to remain closed.
3. Users will be directed to the dumping location by the landfill attendant. The landfill attendant will then create a load summary/receipt and put it in the designated pick up area for users to collect.
4. Tipping fees may be paid using Cash or Cheque at the designated location while observing proper social distancing recommendations of 2m (6ft) where possible. Users are encouraged to provide exact change. Please come prepared with different denominations of bills and coins. Wearing a mask is encouraged.

Cheques should include the load summary/receipt number as issued by the landfill attendant. Users wishing to pay using cheques must come prepared with their own pen. Landfill attendants will not provide pens for public use.

Additionally, users also have the option to have tipping fees invoiced by the Municipal Office to the mailing address associated with the Stanley Landfill pass. Users are asked to ensure their mailing address is current and are asked to not submit payments for invoiced fees until an invoice is received.

Landfill Attendants are not able to issue landfill passes or refund garbage bag tags.
