Bluewater has many facilities, each with their own unique offerings. Be sure to check them out—they're great places for you, your family, and friends to gather.



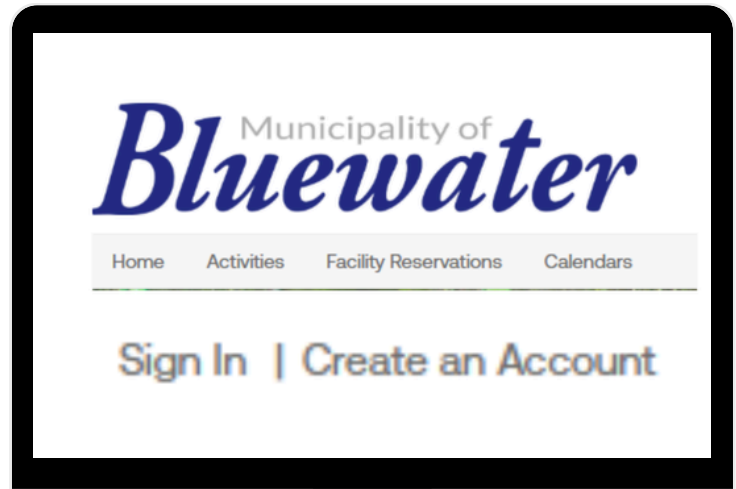

How to Create an Account

1. Go to <https://anc.ca.apm.activecommunities.com/bluewater>
2. Click "Create an Account" at the top right.
3. Enter your email and fill in the required info (including family members, if needed).
4. Add an emergency contact (different from you) and verify everyone's birthdates.
5. Activate your account via the email you'll receive.
6. Log in to ActiveNet.

How to Register for a Program Online

1. Click the Activities tab.
2. Select a category and subcategory, or use Filters to search by program name/code.
3. Click Enroll Now and choose yourself and/or family members (multiple programs allowed).
4. Complete payment online by credit card or in person at the municipal office (cash, cheque, or debit).

How to Book a Facility Online

1. Click Facility Reservations.
2. Search for the facility or select your event type, then choose the appropriate facility.
3. Enter event details (date, time, number of attendees) and complete required questions.
4. Review and e-sign waivers, then click Reserve.
5. Complete payment online by credit card or in person at the municipal office (cash, cheque, or debit).

St. Joseph Park

Corner of Highway 21 and Park Avenue
 Maintained by the St. Joseph and Area Historical Society, this site features a walkway with interpretive signage, gardens, picnic tables, and garbage receptacles.

BEACHES

Bayfield Pier Beach

Bayfield's most popular beach offers drive-up access, parking, and public washrooms. The site operates under shared ownership involving the Pioneer Park Association, the Federal Government, and the Municipality, located beside the Bluewater Marina, it features a large sandy beach, pier walks, and freshwater swimming. Just a short walk from Bayfield's historic village, restaurants, and boutiques, it's an ideal spot for a day on Lake Huron.

Pavilion Road Beach




Located at the end of Pavilion Road just south of Bayfield, Pavilion Road Beach offers parking, a picnic pavilion, washrooms, play equipment, and a walking trail. A winding pathway leads to the sandy shore, making it a great, quieter option for families.

Howard Street Beach

This sandy beach, located just south of Bayfield Pier Beach at the end of Howard Street West, offers ample parking. Access is by stairs, and there are no washrooms on site.

Hay Township Beach

At the end of Sararas Road, this bluff-top beach offers stairway access, lake views from a lookout, and roadside parking.

TRAILS

Klopp Tract & Commemorative Woods

Located on Zurich-Hensall Road (County Rd. 84) between Hensall and Zurich, this site features a commemorative garden, meadow walking path, and a short forest trail. Trails may be soggy after rain.

Linfield Wildlife Area

Located south of Bayfield on Pavilion Road near Goshen Line, this area offers hiking, birdwatching, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, and fishing. Visitors can explore forest trails, brooks, and a pond with diverse wildlife.

River Flats Natural Area

Located in Bayfield along the Bayfield River, this former mill site features 0.7 km of walking trails, picnic areas, a canoe launch, a butterfly meadow, and an osprey nesting site.

Sawmill Trail

Located at the end of Saw Mill Road in Bayfield, this moderate 2 km loop follows the Bayfield River through forested terrain with some steep slopes and historic sawmill features.

Varna Nature Trails

Located behind the Stanley Community Centre in Varna, these trails include the 2.5 km Mavis Trail loop through pine and deciduous forest, featuring stairs, inclines, and scenic views of gullies and the Bayfield River.

Woodland Trail

This 5 km loop in Bayfield is accessed from David Street and offers a moderate hike through forested terrain with hills, streams, short and long route options, and a connection to the Bayfield River.

HIKING BUDDIES PROGRAM

The Hiking Buddy Program is a BRVTA membership benefit that helps members connect with others to hike outside scheduled group hikes and enjoy the trails year-round.

To join or learn more, contact the coordinator, Esther, at info@bayfieldtrails.com; your contact information is shared only with other buddies and hiking coordinator.

Bayfield trails are volunteer-managed and funded through community donations and annual memberships—your support helps keep them accessible for everyone.

Beware of ticks! Ticks are present on the trails and a bite by the deer tick may result in Lyme Disease. Some precautions you can take before embarking on a hike...

- Wear light-coloured clothing, so it's easier to see ticks
- Wear closed-toed shoes (always!)
- Wear long-sleeved shirts
- Wear long pants, tucked into your socks
- Use insect repellent containing DEET
- After outdoor activity put your clothes in the dryer

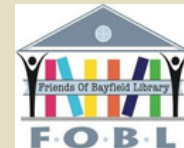

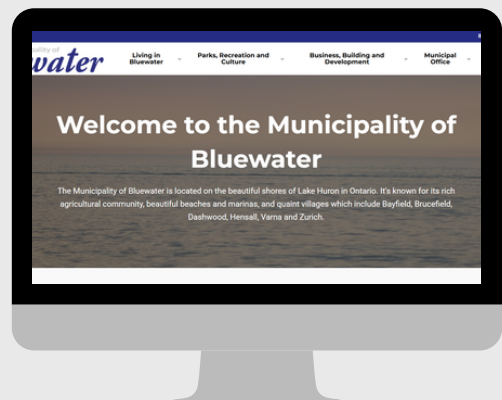
